

EFR Meet & Greet

Please join us on Tuesday, August 30, 2022 for Parent Meet and Greet. We are very excited to open the renovated building to our parents and students. Meet and Greet is typically a popular event, and the hallways and classrooms can be very crowded. Please follow the guidelines below, which will help decrease the number of individuals in the hallways and classrooms at the same time. Due to the renovations and changes at EFR, it may be more difficult to maneuver throughout the building, and there may be some areas that will not be able to be accessed until school begins. Please be patient with us as we get situated with all of the changes.

A folder of information for you, including your child's schedule, will be available to pick up in the designated location based on student grade level. 5th and 6th grade: EFR Cafeteria and 7th and 8th grade: EFR Gym. Folders will be organized alphabetically by your student's last name.

5th and 7th grade parents/student should attend during the time frame of 5:00-5:45 pm. 6th and 8th grade parents/student should attend in the time frame of 5:45-6:30 pm. Teachers will be available during the alternate grade level times if you cannot participate in the grade level scheduled time frame.

It is an "open house" format allowing you to stop by your child's classrooms and meet teachers in the order you prefer.

If you would like to share specific information about your child with teachers, it is best to send them an email. I will include staff email addresses in the 2022-2023 EFR Back to School Newsletter that will be emailed home soon.

Teachers will not be distributing handouts at Parent Meet and Greet. An introductory note, class syllabus, and pertinent course-related information will be distributed to students and emailed to parents during the first week of school. Picking up the red information folder, putting a face with the teacher's name, and dropping off requested class donations to the 1st hour teacher should take approximately twenty minutes.

Students can also access their locker during the grade level time frame. The student's locker number and the combination are printed on their schedule. Students can put their school supplies in their locker or bring them on the first day of school.

Lockers: Please do not purchase a locker shelf. Shelves push against the sides of the locker and often jam the lockers on each side. The lockers are narrow, and the space is needed for school supplies, a backpack, and a jacket. Students can decorate the inside panel of their locker, but please use magnets instead of tape to minimize possible locker damage.

Lockers have a three-combination lock. If your child is concerned about opening a combination lock, here is a helpful video: [Master Lock - How to open a combination locker](#) . Students should not fret about this (I know, easier said than done). Students will get time to practice opening their locker once the school year begins.

If you cannot attend Meet and Greet on August 30, you can access your student's schedule on Skyward beginning the morning of Wednesday, August 31. If you cannot attend Meet and Greet and would like to visit the school before the first day, EFR will be open on Wednesday, August 31, from 3:00-5:00 pm. Please bring a copy of your child's schedule with you when you visit.

There will be plenty of staff in the hallways on the first days of school helping students find their classrooms. It is not expected that your child visit school before September 6. We are just making this time frame available as a courtesy for our parents/students.
