PURPOSE OF PROJECT

The **Frankenmuth School District Foundation** program provides funding to programs and projects for Frankenmuth School District students for educational initiatives and projects not currently supported by school budgets.

The program is meant to:

- Enhance student experiences and curriculum activities
- Develop projects to facilitate different learning styles
- Motivate student curiosity and learning
- Supplement additional funding sources
- Purchase educational materials and/or bring non-traditional resources to the classroom
- Develop and share innovative methods and tools for teaching
- Inspire professional development and growth

Although not specifically precluded, applications for continuation of existing programs may receive lower funding priority. (See "Review Criteria" information.)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

All Frankenmuth School District teachers, instructional staff, and advisors are eligible to apply. While more than one application may be submitted, only one grant will be awarded per individual, per year.

GRANT AMOUNTS

The typical grant award is expected to be between \$100 and \$500.

GRANTS FOR EXCELLENCE REVIEW CRITERIA

Applications are reviewed on a competitive basis by an advisory committee consisting of Frankenmuth School District administrators, board members, and teachers. The advisory committee evaluates individual proposals based on:

- Number of students involved in and/or benefiting from the project
- Expected impact of the program
- Effectiveness of the activity or program
- Potential to improve student achievement and morale
- Cost effectiveness
- Enhancement of the skills of teachers and support staff
- Potential for continuation and/or replication

EXCLUDED PROGRAMS

The following will not be considered for funds under the **Frankenmuth School District Foundation**:

- Sports camps
- Faith based activities
- General summer recreational camps
- Regular high school or college credit classes
- Private music lessons

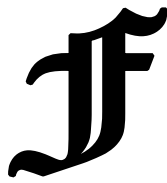
EVALUATION

Grantees are expected to provide a written report to the Frankenmuth School District Foundation at the conclusion of their project. This report should include a financial statement, description of the project, and the impact on students.
