Mission

The mission of the Frankenmuth School District Foundation is to collect and distribute funds in order to improve the educational opportunities for Frankenmuth School students. We aim to strengthen our community's commitment to education by offering our students the resources needed to develop their academic talents and intellectual capacities. We seek to broaden horizons and provide challenging learning opportunities. We wish to facilitate cooperative ventures among the Foundation, community groups, and the school district. Further, the foundation encourages school/community partnerships by providing a means for individuals and organizations to share resources with the schools and students in order to enhance learning.

General Guidelines for Individual Student Grants

In general, funds will be provided for tuition, program fees, and other costs for enhancement and enrichment activities that are not available within the public school setting. We anticipate that most grants will range from \$100 to \$500. Grants are awarded via a written application process.

Any educational institute, workshop, music, or arts program NOT conducted by the Frankenmuth School District is eligible. The program must be educational in nature. Examples may include student exchange programs, a university or other summer youth program in science, math, music, journalism, yearbook, choir, drama, vocational education, or an extra curricular fine arts program. NO sports camps, faith based activities, general summer recreational camps, regular high school, or college credit classes, therapeutic programs, or private music lessons are eligible. Material and equipment grants may be provided for individual high school students who take an approved independent study class as part of their curriculum.

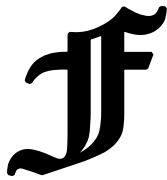
