

FSD website policy and guidelines

The Board of Education and Superintendent authorizes staff members, students, and contracted vendors to create web content for the district website for publication on the internet.

This authorization is given with the understanding that all staff members, students, and contracted vendors will comply with State and Federal law (e.g., copyright laws, Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA), Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504), Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPM), and reflect the professional image/brand of Frankenmuth School District, its employees, and students.

All website content must be consistent with our Board's Mission Statement.

Website content created and submitted by students must be approved by the appropriate FSD staff member or teacher prior to posting.

The purpose of all content on our website is to educate, inform, and communicate. This is the criteria that will be used to guide both the development and evaluation of content.

Appropriate third-party links on our website are allowed, Examples include our parent/student portals, health department, government, media channels, educational activity associations, and our instructional support links. We monitor our third-party links to see that they comply with State and Federal law (e.g. copyright laws, CIPA, Section 504, ADA, SOPPA and COPPA).

We also respect everyone's privacy. We do not share email addresses and phone numbers with outside vendors. We only collect and gather them as a school district to communicate schedules, events, school news, and emergency alerts.
