We recommend that all students, regardless of grade level, have the following school supplies:

A couple of pencil boxes or zippered pencil bags to hold the following supplies that will stay in the student's locker:

English: 1" 3 ring binder w/ 4 divider tabs, loose leaf lined paper, spiral notebook

Band: 2 sharpened #2 pencils, 1" 3-ring binder with a place for pencils, 20 sheet protectors

English: 1" 3-ring binder w/ 3 divider tabs, composition book

Math: Folder, a basic 4-function calculator

Science: 1" 3-ring binder w/ 2 divider tabs, lined paper, post-it notes

Social Studies: 1" 3-ring binder

Band: 2 sharpened #2 pencils, 1" 3-ring binder with a place for pencils, 20 sheet protectors

Seventh Grade:

English & Reading: 1" 3-ring binder w/ 5 tabbed dividers, loose-leaf lined paper, composition notebook, folder

Math: Folder, 12" ruler with English & Metric measurement, compass, protractor, and scientific calculator that does square roots & fractions*

Social Studies: Spiral notebook, folder, brown paper bag

Science: 2 composition books

Band: 2 sharpened #2 pencils, 1" 3-ring binder with a place for pencils, 20 sheet protectors

Eighth Grade:

English: 1" 3-ring binder w/ 5 divider tabs, loose-leaf lined paper, folder

Science: 2 composition books
