We recommend that all students, regardless of grade level, have the following school supplies:

A couple of pencil boxes or zippered pencil bags to hold the following supplies that will stay in the student's locker.

Fifth Grade:

English: 1-3" ring binder used specifically for English w/4 divider tabs, loose leaf lined paper, spiral notebook

Math: 1-2" ring binder used specifically for Math, loose leaf lined paper

Science: 1-2" ring binder used specifically for Science w/4 divider tabs, loose leaf lined paper

Social Studies: 1 3"-ring binder w/loose leaf paper used for Social Studies notebook paper & an extra-large book cover

Band: 1" heavy-duty BLACK 3-ring binder, pencil case, 3-sharpened #2 pencils, 15 sheet protectors, and lined loose-leafed paper

Elective Classes (non-band students): Spiral notebook

Technology Exploratory Trimester Class (all students take): Notepad (any size)

Sixth Grade:

English: 1" 3-ring binder w/ 3 divider tabs, composition book

Math: Folder, a basic 4-function calculator

Science: 1" 3-ring binder w/ 1 divider tab, lined paper

Social Studies: 1" 3-ring binder

Pencil case to bring to all classes

Band: 1" heavy-duty BLACK 3-ring binder, pencil case, 3-sharpened #2 pencils, 15 sheet protectors, and lined loose-leafed paper

Seventh Grade:

English & Reading: 1" 3-ring binder w/ 5 tabbed dividers, loose-leaf lined paper, composition notebook, folder

Math: Folder, 12" ruler with English & Metric measurement, compass, protractor, and scientific calculator that does square roots & fractions*

Social Studies: Spiral notebook, folder, brown paper bag

Science: 2 wide-ruled 1-subject notebooks

Band: 1" heavy-duty BLACK 3-ring binder, pencil case, 3-sharpened #2 pencils, 15 sheet protectors, and lined loose-leafed paper

Elective Classes (non-band students): 1" 3-ring binder w/4 tabbed dividers, loose-leaf lined paper, folder

Communications: Loose leaf paper, note cards, folder, 4x6 notecards

Eighth Grade:

English: 1" 3-ring binder w/ 5 divider tabs, loose-leaf lined paper, folder

Math: Folder, 12" ruler w/English & metric measurements, compass, protractor, & a scientific calculator that does square roots & fractions*

Social Studies: Spiral notebook, folder, brown paper bag

Science: 2 wide-ruled 1-subject notebooks

Band: 1" heavy-duty BLACK 3-ring binder, pencil case, 3-sharpened #2 pencils, 15 sheet protectors, and lined loose-leafed paper

Elective Classes (non-band students): 1" 3-ring binder w/4 tabbed dividers, loose-leaf lined paper

Young Adult Literature Exploratory Trimester Class (all students take): Folder, spiral bound notebook.

German / Spanish (all students take both this year): 1" 3-ring binder, w/4 tabbed dividers, loose-leaf lined paper
