



## EFR Summer Reading 2023 for Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Graders

We encourage students to continue to read on a regular basis and to discover new authors and books to enjoy over the summer break. Encourage your student to try non-fiction titles on their favorite topic and to participate in the summer reading program at their local library. Research indicates that summer reading is critical for students to retain knowledge and skills learned in the previous school year. Please make sure that time is made this summer to enjoy reading!

Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> graders are **required to read two books over the course of the summer AND take the AR tests over the books.** The books are of the individual student's choice and should be on the individual student's reading level. **Students who complete their local library's Summer Reading program may turn in their proof of participation for extra credit in the fall.**

**Students will be able to access AR tests all summer at home. Wickson also has computers available to take AR tests. AR tests can be taken daily between 7:30 am - 9:00 pm.**
